Dear Friends of SCARS,

Many of the SCARS dogs are here because someone spoke up: a high kill shelter worker pleads for help relocating a litter of newborns; a motorist reports a skinny puppy wandering a lonely road at nightfall; a neighbor notices two dogs without food or water chained behind an obviously deserted home; or, a veterinarian has an injured dog dumped in his doorway. The cries for help are endless - unfortunately our resources are not. Our initial vet bills average \$300-\$500 per dog depending on the situation. Some have substantial physical injuries. Many have multiple parasites. Very few have been neutered, and far too many are starvation cases. We are often the last refuge for a dog who has been abandoned or abused. As everyone knows, this has not been a prosperous year for our country: continued unemployment and foreclosures; an uneasy stock market; the disaster in the gulf; and a long hot summer. None of this bodes well for the animals who share our world. But you can make a difference.
