Dear Friends of SCARS,

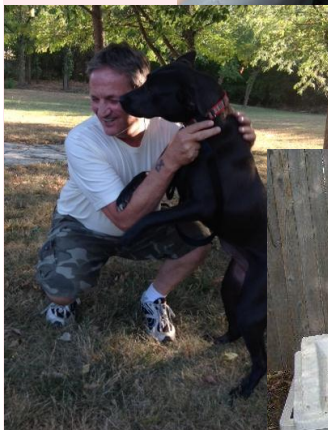

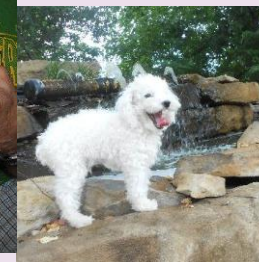
